We are very happy to share with you about Cambodia and we thank you to everyone the member of Glencross Church who always offer a lot offering for support camps in our country.

Through all funds that you always give to CCI and CCI transfer for us every year we are here trying from heart to prepare this great blessing by love and transfer the God's words to reach many churches and children in this Cambodia.

We see that all funds you have sent until 2011 have made many churches to be prosperous and many children hear God's words and believe in Jesus through our Camping and Follow up program.

For the follow up program we have done after the Camping, before follow up we always train the counsellors to teach on follow up, in year 2011 we have separated the training course to be 4courses.

#### The 1st course on

- -28/04/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at Mongkol Borei district, BanteayMeanchey Province, the attendant 69, female 45.
  - -30/04/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up  $\,$  at BAG church , Battambang Province the attendant 149, female 85.

#### The 2<sup>nd</sup> course on

- -06/07/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at BAG church, Battambang Province the attendant 103, female 68.
- -06/07/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at Nazarene church, Thmar Koul district, the attendant 30, female 9.
- -09/07/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at Mongkol Borei church, BanteayMeanchey Province, the attendant 78, female 47.

#### The 3rd course on

- -06/10/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at BAG church, Battambang Province, the attendant 142, female 65.
- -07/10/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at Mongkol Borei church, BanteayMeanchey Province, the attendant 93, female 28.

#### The 4th course on-

- -29/11/2011 has a counsellor training for follow up at Mongkol Borei church, Banteay Meanchey Province, the attendant 70, female 45.
- -03/12/2011 the counsellor training for follow up at BAG church, Battambang Province, the attendant 135, female 77.

In all every courses we always train the counsellors about:

-Pedagogy in teaching children

- -How to control
- -Children's song
- -God's words (preaching, story, memory verse)
- -Games
- Hygiene for children
- -How to be a good manner

After each training, all counsellors have to teach all what they have learned to children every week in their own Camp at area.

We see that through our training and follow up teaching every week in 2011 God had bless all counsellors have the special gift for teach children to control and got a lot of wisdom in God's words to be strong in faith and can help their church own self. And for children they are very happy in life to join follow up by sing the praise songs, listening God's words, memory God's words, play Games ... and also have some snack every week. More over the great result that we get many children have changed their life difference before come to camp and follow up program and now they become good person by obey parent and love God and their friend all heart.

In 2011 we had 98 camps. And the result in 2011 through Counsellors Training for Camp, the attendant of counsellor had 512, female 295. The attendant of children in Camp around 5,452, Female 3,090. All amounts that changed to believe Jesus had around 2,610, female 1,475.

In this year 2012 we will increase to 100 camps (churches). And in Cambodia there are many churches have heard about our camp and they have interesting and contact us but because we have no ability yet to catch them and help them because we still have lacked some more funds for our 100 camps, so we have decided only 100 camps this year.

We are Cambodia Children's Camps staffs and the representative all camps in Cambodia, would like to thank you The Lord our God, CCl and Glencross church that always take care and love children in Cambodia and help them have opportunity to know God when they still young and we hopeful that they will become the person who grow up by faith and full love to continue to change their family's life and Cambodia in the sort future time. ## MCC Manitoba Financial Report for 2010-2011 and Request for 2012

To the Member Congregations of MCC Manitoba:

MCC is – as stated in our theme for the current calendar year – "a table of sharing" in the name of Christ. We at Mennonite Central Committee Manitoba have just completed our financial year (August 31) and we have special reason to give thanks to God for the sharing by our donors: individuals, organizations and congregations.

2010-2011 Financial Summary

MCC's supporters shared ca.\$10.2 million for MCC's relief, development and peace building efforts. Of this total MCC Manitoba forwarded ca \$7.55 million for international and national programs, including ca. \$1.2 million above budget for MCC's response to disasters in Pakistan and Japan and the famine in East Africa. Within our province MCC Manitoba expended ca. \$705,000 from constituency sources plus ca. \$325,000 from government sources for a variety of ministries addressing social and spiritual needs. We also used ca. \$870,000 for administration and fund-raising in Manitoba. For details see the Annual MCC Manitoba report book and / or request the audited financial report form the MCC Manitoba office.

2011-2012 Budget Summary

The next fiscal year is a seven-month year as we transition to a new fiscal year end of March 31<sup>st</sup>. Thus our budgets for income and expenses (ca. \$5,200,000) are both set at just over 7/12ths of the past year. We are budgeting \$1,100,000 for activities within Manitoba and \$3,900,000 for forwardings for international and national MCC programs. Contributions for major disaster responses will be forwarded in addition to the budgeted commitment.

Sharing Possibilities

We ask you, our member congregations, to share through MCC to alleviate suffering and to build peace in the name of Christ. This sharing could take the form of:

- Including a contribution to MCC in your budget OR
- Continuing or increasing (by 1-2%) your budgeted contribution to MCC, if this is already your practice AND
- Forwarding to MCC the donations for individual members and groups: AND
- Holding special collections for MCC's programs and projects: AND/OR
- Encouraging direct donations to MCC by mail or online.

We thank our God every time we remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of our prayers for you all because of your <u>sharing</u> in the gospel. (Phil. 1:2)
