School Kit Contents: 4 spiral or perforated notebooks (8 ½ x 10 ½ in and 70 sheets) 8 unsharpened pencils, 1 ruler (flat, flexible plastic; indicating both 30 cm & 12 in) 12 colored pencils (in packaging) 1 large pencil eraser. School kits are distributed in a useful double drawstring cloth bag (11inx16in). You may sew the bag yourself, request bags from an MCC collection center, or donate contents that we will place in a bag.
