Parenting Course: LOVING ON PURPOSE By Danny Silk

"Loving on Purpose" is a DVD based parenting course by Danny Silk. It gives a fresh perspective to parenting and how we can prepare our kids for the kingdom of God so they can relate to God in a healthy way. All parents struggle with getting their kids to obey. This study shows how the age old way of intimidation and punishment to get obedience or compliance may work but will damage your heart to heart connection with your child. Instead of punishment and intimidation tactics, it focuses on training your kids to handle their God given freedom of choice and to protect their parents heart and relationship with them. This is a model of the kingdom of heaven to our children.

Danny Silk is very thorough in teaching truth from scripture, uncovering lies we believe and explaining why we need to rethink how we parent. He shows us how to approach parenting with a perspective of preparing our kids for the kingdom of heaven and how to handle their freedom (choices) and their side of their relationship with others and our Heavenly Father.
