The plans for the additional Sunday school class rooms have changed since the April congregational meeting because a new idea was brought forward by the B & A Board which has been reviewed and approved by Church Council. The two Pastors offices will be combined to make one larger multi-purpose room that will have enough lockable storage space for the youth supplies and the room will be divided by a curtain to make two Sunday school class rooms for Sunday mornings. This will be happening at the same time as the elevator project.

We have received a confidential pledge towards a church expansion as discussed at the February and April congregational meetings. Church Council has decided to appoint a building planning committee and have the committee present the plans, including costs at the November congregational meeting for review and then have a vote to decide if we, as a congregation, are ready to take on an expansion project.
