## Sunday School

Sunday school has once again started.

At the Program Committee level it was discussed to try a few changes, as to the order of things.

When students arrive at church @ 9:30, they will go directly to their classrooms, at which time they will be registered as "on time", they will give their offerings, and recite their Bible verses. This should take approx. 10 min. Then all students will proceed to singing area – together with their teacher. Age 3 – Grade 1 downstairs and Grade 2 and up in the sanctuary. After 10-15 minutes of singing, everyone will proceed to their classroom again.

The reason for this trial change is to see if we can get more students to be on time for the singing and ALL students to hear the beginning of the Bible Story that teachers have so faithfully prepared. It is only showing respect for everyone else when you arrive on time and don't disrupt the class.

There will be a small incentive for students who have arrived on time at the end of the quarter, and each student will still be registered present each Sunday even if late.
