### Dual Services and Sunday School

In order to comply with the current Covid-19 restrictions,  
we will be making the change to two services. The early  
Church Service will begin at 9 am. Sunday School begins  
at 10 am and the second Church Service will be at 11 am.

### Covid-19 Restrictions under Code Orange

Church Council had a meeting in regards to how the Code Orange  
(Pandemic Response System) will affect our church services.  
Under the code orange restrictions we will be required to make the  
following changes in order to comply with the change in regulations.

**1) Reduction of capacity for faith based gatherings from 30% to 20%  
of our capacity.** We will continue with two services for now, and will  
evaluate the attendance numbers and will consider adding a third  
service if necessary.

**2) Physical Distancing Requirements.** In order to better comply with  
physical distancing requirements in Sunday School the high school  
students (grades 9-12) will join the Adult Sunday School in the  
Sanctuary and fellowship hall in order to make more room downstairs  
for the other Sunday School Classes

**3) Mandatory use of Masks in Indoor Public Places.** We will provide  
masks to those who need one for entering, moving about, and leaving  
the church. Masks may be removed when a person is seated and safely  
distanced from others. This will apply to everyone ages 5 and up in all  
church activities until the restrictions have been lifted.  
Please continue to pray for our community, and local churches and  
each other as we live out our faith during this challenging time.
