- January 21 **Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end.** He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom,
 Isaiah 9:7a
- January 28 establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. **The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.**

- February 11 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and **if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.**

- February 18 If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

- February 25 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
 1 Corinthians 13:4
- March 3 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.
